Final Examinations 2013-2014

Dear Parents/Guardians

In an effort to promote student achievement and success, we will once again, be following a schedule in which all students will write one exam per day in their own classroom, with their own teacher supervising the exam.

This semester, the schedule will be as follows:

Day 2	Thursday January 23, 2014	ALL Period 2 Classes	8:30 a.m.
Day 3	Friday January 24, 2014	ALL Period 3 Classes	8:30 a.m.
Day 4	Monday January 27, 2014	ALL Period 4 Classes	8:30 a.m.
Day 5	Tuesday January 28, 2014	ALL Period 5 Classes	8:30 a.m.

Some students who require the assistance of the Special Education Resource Department or Student Success may write their examinations in various assigned areas under the supervision of the Special Education Resource Team or Student Success teachers.

In the event of a school closure due to inclement weather, the schedule will be delayed by one day, (e.g. Wednesday being the snow day, exams scheduled for that day will be moved to Thursday and so forth to complete the examination cycle).

Please note that Wednesday, January 29 is a P.A. Day that will be reserved as a makeup day for any exams cancelled due to inclement weather. Students who are not available to write an exam on this day will NOT be allowed to write the exam on an alternate day and a grade of zero will be assigned for the missed exam.

Lastly, be aware that while formal final exams begin on January 22nd, the period of time leading up to this date is a vitally important time in our school year. Not only does exam preparation take place in classes, but many courses also have in class exams, lab exams, performance tasks, culminating activities, etc taking place. Please do your best to keep the time leading up to exams free from appointments, holidays or any other events that will cause your son or daughter to miss class time.
